

# TEDxJUET 2025

On May 3rd, the spirit of innovation and inspiration came alive at Jaypee University of Engineering and Technology, Guna as **TEDxJUET 2025** opened its doors to a day filled with powerful stories and transformative ideas. The event began around 10:30 AM with an opening note by Ms. Priya Jha, co-organiser and content writer of the TEDx license, who introduced this year's theme - **“Resonance.”** She beautifully described it as the hidden connection between our struggles and successes, the energy that turns a whisper into a movement and connects our inner thoughts to the outside world.

The event officially started with a traditional lamp lighting ceremony to seek blessings, performed by Dr. Abhishek Shukla (Faculty Advisor, TEDxJUET), Dr. Sandeep Srivastava (Chairman, JUET Youth Club and HOD, HSS), and organisers Priya Jha and Hardik Sharma. A soulful Saraswati Vandana followed, setting the tone for a day of thoughtful discussions and deep reflection.

The lineup of speakers brought together voices from various fields, each with a story worth sharing. From entrepreneurs to psychologists, mountaineers to YouTubers, every speaker offered a unique perspective, proving that powerful ideas truly come from all walks of life.

The audience was taken on a journey through the digital world by **Sheik Farooq Chisty**, an entrepreneur who explored the evolution of the internet and web. **Charvi Jain**, a psychologist and founder of “Over a Cup of Tea,” shared how empathy, not anger, is what the world needs to heal emotional wounds. **Vrinda Gupta** gave a powerful talk about the complex role marriage plays in society—how it can either build a person up or leave them emotionally broken.

**Babulal Dahiya**, a humble 82-year-old Padma Shri awardee, farmer, conservationist, and poet, shared stories from his lifelong dedication to preserving nature and culture. **Bhavana Daheriya**, an inspiring mountaineer, took the audience up to the summit of Mount Everest, sharing her story of perseverance and courage as she battled freezing temperatures and oxygen-thin air to achieve her dream.

Among all the speakers, **Dheeraj Rathi** stood out with his visionary talk. As Managing Director of **EVOVIS RKCA**, he spoke about his work with global startups, using artificial intelligence and analytics to build a virtual accelerator platform that connects businesses across continents. Backed by Japanese investors and trusted by Fortune 100 companies and government bodies, his work is helping reshape the startup ecosystem in Asia. His insights struck a chord with budding entrepreneurs and faculty members alike, offering a rare glimpse into the future of global business.

Another speaker who received a thunderous response was **Gajendra Purohit**, a beloved YouTuber with over 1.64 million subscribers. His talk was a breath of fresh air, urging students not to get trapped in the usual 9-to-5 routine but to follow their passions with confidence. His friendly, relatable style made him an instant hit—especially with students who already looked up to him before he even stepped on campus.

**Arpit Dwivedi**, a rationalist and science communicator, challenged modern myths and encouraged critical thinking. **Sunny Gupta**, a life coach and education reformer, talked about why children naturally love learning but grow to dislike school—highlighting the need to rethink our education system. The final talk was given by **Mohit Sharma**, founder and CEO of Blacklisted, whose story titled “*The Stubborn Story*” showed how relentless determination can help anyone achieve their goals.

The event ended on a warm and celebratory note with a **memento distribution ceremony**, followed by a **team reveal** and **vote of thanks** by organisers Priya Jha and Hardik Sharma. A friendly **interaction session** allowed students and faculty to connect with the speakers, share conversations, and take photos to capture the day's memories.
