#### NOTE

1. The first round of counselling based on All India Rank (AIR) of JEE (Mains) 2025 for admission in BTech Programs will be held at IIIT Noida, Sector-62 Campus for all Jaypee Universities.
2. Counseling and admissions based on 10+2 Marks Merit 2025 for specific admissions to Jaypee University of Engineering and Technology, Guna will be held at Jaypee University of Engineering and Technology, Guna only.
3. In order to ensure branch of their choice, candidates are suggested to apply under both the categories separately and pay separate Application Fee.
4. JEE (Mains) application form is common to all the Universities. However, application for 10+2 marks based admission form is University specific to which candidate is seeking admission.
5. PGET and PhD entrance test will be conducted at JUET Guna.
6. Admissions are non-transferable within the Jaypee Universities.
7. Visit website [www.juet.ac.in](http://www.juet.ac.in) for further details.

## 2. ADMISSION INSTRUCTIONS (GENERAL)

- 2.1 Application forms for admission through all modes in all programs are available online at [www.juet.ac.in](http://www.juet.ac.in) and offline at the admission counter of all Jaypee Universities. Application forms can also be obtained by post by sending a demand draft of application fee to “Admission Cell, Jaypee University of Engineering & Technology, AB Road, Raghogarh, Guna-473226 (M.P.)”.
- 2.2 Candidates who procure the application form after payment of the application fee are not required to make any further payment while submitting the application form.
- 2.3 If a candidate is applying for JEE (Main) 2025 based admission but also wants to apply for 10+2 marks-based admission and/ or admission under NRI category, he/she must apply separately and pay the required application fee.
- 2.4 Applications received after the last date of submission will not be accepted and candidates shall have no claim on the merit list and subsequent admission to the program.
- 2.5 Hosting of the offline Application Forms of different programs on the website of the University shall be done in a phased manner. Candidates are required to check the website of the university [www.juet.ac.in](http://www.juet.ac.in) regularly for the latest updates and also take necessary action as per the information hosted on the website.
- 2.6 **Display of Application Status:** Candidates shall generally be able to see the receipt details of their applications and essential data on the website only after 7 working days of submission of the Application form.
- 2.7 Candidates are advised to keep with them a copy of the e-mail along with the photocopy of the filled-in Application Form(s). In any case, all issues regarding non-receipt of Application form(s) in the Admission Cell must be resolved before declaration of merit list. No appeals thereafter will be entertained in this regard

3.2 **The Application fee can be paid through any of the following modes:**

- (i) Online at Admission portal of [www.juet.ac.in](http://www.juet.ac.in) through internet banking/debit card/credit card.
- (ii) JEE main based admission (3.1 S.No.-1) - Demand Draft in favour of “Jaypee Institutes Admission Account” payable at Noida/Delhi.
- (iii) For all other categories of admission, Demand Draft in favour of “Jaypee University of Engineering and Technology” payable at Guna.
- (iv) By cash/debit or credit card/UPI at the admission counter of the university.

## 4. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

### 4.1 B Tech Programs :

- a) Candidates who have passed 10+2/Equivalent exam in 2023, 2024 or appearing in 2025 are eligible to apply.
- b) The candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or its equivalent (as defined in JEE (Main) 2025 examination) with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one subject out of Chemistry, Computer Science, Electronics, Information Technology, Informatics Practices, Technical Vocational Subject, Agriculture, Engineering Graphics, Business Studies, Entrepreneurship and English. For Civil Engineering/Chemical Engineering/Mechanical Engineering Programs Chemistry is must with Physics and Mathematics.
- c) For JEE (Main) based admissions, candidates should have minimum of 60% marks (55% for SC/ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or its equivalent examination.
- d) For 10+2 marks based admissions, candidates should have minimum of 60% marks (55% for SC/ ST) in aggregate in 10+2 or its equivalent examination. Other conditions at 4.1(a) and 4.1(b) will remain same as above.
- e) Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to BTech will be required to submit a Gap Period affidavit available at the University Website [www.juet.ac.in](http://www.juet.ac.in).

### 4.2 BTech Programs (Lateral Entry):

- a. Passed Diploma examination with at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) in the same branch in which admission in BTech 2nd year is sought. OR
- b. Passed BTech 1st Year from a recognized University as defined by UGC , with at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ST) or equivalent CGPA in the same branch in which admission in BTech 2nd year is sought. OR
- c. Passed BSc Degree from a recognized University as defined by UGC, with at least 45% marks (40% for SC/ ST) and passed 10+2 with mathematics as a subject. OR
- d. Passed D.Voc stream in the same or allied sector.

### 4.3 BBA Program:

- a. Candidate should have passed or appeared in 10+2 examination or equivalent from a recognized educational board
- b. Candidates with gap year (if any) between their 10+2 and admission to BBA will be required to submit a Gap Period affidavit available at the University Website [www.juet.ac.in](http://www.juet.ac.in).

**4.4 Diploma Program** - Candidate should have passed or appeared in 2025 in 10th or equivalent examination from a recognized educational board with Science and Mathematics as subjects. For direct entry into II year Diploma, candidates should have passed ITI in relevant branch.

**4.5 MSc Program** in Physics, Mathematics, and Chemistry – Candidates should have passed BSc (Hons)/BSc under 10+2+3 pattern securing the minimum of 55% marks (50% for SC/ST) or equivalent grade point on a 10 point scale in the aggregate in Science subjects (considering all the three years of BSc course). The subject in which admission is sought must be the Hons. subject at BSc (Hons.) Level/ a subject studied in all three years at undergraduate level.

**4.6 MTech Program** – Candidates should have passed BE/BTech examination with 60% marks or 6.0 CGPA on 10 point scale in the relevant discipline.

**4.7 PhD Program** – PG degree with 55% (50% for SC/ST) marks from a recognized University/Institution in the relevant subject in regular mode. Admission will be based on the PhD entrance test followed by interview conducted at JUET, Guna. NET/SLET/GATE qualified candidates are exempted from appearing in the PhD Entrance test but have to appear in the interview.

**4.8** All admissions will be subject to verification of facts from the original certificates/documents of the candidates. If an applicant is found ineligible at a later stage after admission to the University, his/her admission will stand automatically cancelled. The decision of the Admissions Committee of the University regarding the eligibility for admission to the program shall be final and binding on the candidate.

**4.9** Ensuring eligibility for the admission to the program, under the defined category of admission, is the sole responsibility of the candidate.

- 4.10 Candidates appearing in qualifying examinations prescribed above in the year 2025 can also apply for admission. However, if admission is based on marks in the qualifying examination, the result of the examination must be submitted before the preparation of merit list as per admission calendar 2025.

## 5. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM

- 5.1 Application form for admission can be submitted ONLINE or OFFLINE.
- 5.2 For Online Applications :
- Log on to [www.juet.ac.in](http://www.juet.ac.in) and click on Apply online link of the related program
  - Thereafter, follow the on-screen prompts to fill up the application form and make the payment through Credit card/Debit card/Net banking.
  - Once the payment has been successfully made, the candidate shall be allotted an Application ID, which must be preserved for future reference. The candidate shall also get an e-mail of confirmation.
  - During the online application, candidates are required to upload the passport size photograph of self and signatures of self and the parent.
  - Candidates should keep a copy of the application form for all future references.
  - Process to be followed if payment of application fee is to be made through Demand Draft:
    - Submit the application form on-line.
    - Take a print out of application form and attach the Demand Draft with it made in favour of “Jaypee University of Engineering & Technology”, payable at Guna.
    - Send the same by post to Admission Cell , Jaypee University of Engineering & Technology ,AB Road, Raghogarh, Guna, 473226, (MP).
- 5.3 For Offline Application forms procured from Admission Counter of the University:
- Fill-in the Application Form neatly without any cut/overwriting with black/blue pen.
  - Fill-in all fields, affix the photograph and sign the application form.

## 6. RESERVATION OF SEATS

- 6.1 Reservation for SC/ST/Kashmiri Migrant candidates will be as per the provisions of GOI for all programs.
- 6.2 10% seats at JUET, Guna are reserved for wards of serving and retired Armed Forces and Paramilitary Forces Personnel.
- 6.3 A concession of 30% in tuition fee is available for the candidates admitted under the categories given in point 6.2 above. An additional 5% concession in tuition fee is also available for the wards of war widows and personnel martyred in action.

## 7. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - JEE (MAIN) 2025 RANK BASED B.TECH ADMISSION

**7.1** The merit list amongst the Applications received for admission to Jaypee Universities shall be drawn on the basis of All India Rank in JEE (Main) 2025 Examination. Rank in no other category will be considered for drawing merit.

**7.2 CHOICE(S) OF INSTITUTES/BRANCHES** - During counselling, the candidates will be required to select any one Institute/University and give choice for any/all the programs of that Institute/ University.

### **7.3 COUNSELLING INTIMATION:**

- a) Counselling dates shall be displayed on the website of the University.
- b) Intimation of counselling shall be sent to all shortlisted candidates on their registered e-mail IDs. Candidates must ensure the correctness of their e-mail IDs while filling the application form and check all folders (including spam) of their e-mail for communication on counselling.
- c) Ignorance/lapses, if any, in participating in the allotted counselling slot shall not be accepted as an excuse to participate in counselling at a later date.

### **7.4 COUNSELLING**

The first round of counselling will be common and conducted at JIIT Noida for admissions to all the four universities, i.e. JIIT-Noida, JUIT-Waknaghat, JUET-Guna and JU-Anoopshahr. The subsequent round (s) of counselling will be held in respective Universities.

### **7.5 Process of Counselling:**

- a) 1st round of counselling shall be held at JIIT-Noida on 17-18 June 2025. Candidates are advised to check their Email for the counselling intimation.
- b) All candidates (including those appearing in 10+2 examination in 2025) are required to upload their results on getadmissions portal latest by 05 June, 2025.
- c) Candidates called for counselling shall be permitted to exercise choice of only one University at the time of counselling.
- d) Candidates shall be allowed to exercise choice of any program/branches within the selected University.
- e) Allocation of seats will be done as per merit prepared based on all India rank of JEE (Mains) 2025.
- f) Seats in the programs shall be allocated on the basis of preferences indicated at the time of counselling.
- g) The candidate shall have the option of up-gradation in the programs /branches as per the merit and priority of choices exercised by them but within the same university.
- h) During counselling a candidate can confirm the seat available or choose to be in waitlist by depositing Rs. 75000/- (seventy five thousand). The amount will be adjusted against academic fee dues of first semester for candidates who are offered admission or will be kept as wait listed fee till admission is offered.
- i) Fee can be deposited through Debit Card/credit Card / UPI / Demand Draft favoring "Jaypee Institutes Admission Account" payable at Noida/Delhi. (Cheque and Cash are NOT acceptable.)
- j) On allocation of a seat, candidate will be offered Provisional Admission Letter.

### **Note:**

- i. Candidates are advised to judiciously fill their choice form at the time of counselling.
- ii. The candidates have the option of freezing confirmed seats allotted to them any time before up-gradation is carried out, if they are satisfied with their allotted program and they do not want any further changes through up-gradation.



## 8. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - 10+2 MARKS BASED B.TECH ADMISSION

**8.1** A separate application form must be filled by the students for each University seeking admission in B.Tech programs on the basis of 10+2 marks .

### **8.2 Counselling Process :**

- a) Counselling for candidates seeking admission based on merit of 10+2 marks at JUET will be held at JUET, Guna on the scheduled dates mentioned above in the admission calendar 2025. Any change in the admission calendar 2025 will be notified for the information of the candidates well in time by the university.
- b) The merit shall be drawn based on the marks obtained in 10+2 in Maths and Physics and one subject as mentioned in Section 4.1 (b). with highest score.
- c) Candidates are responsible for uploading their results before preparation of merit list.
- d) For admission, the candidates will be asked to participate in the counselling process by registering themselves for admission based on 10+2 marks. The candidate will have to provide the 10+2 marks and update the 10+2 marks sheet through the link provided through email after declaration of 10+2 result.

### **8.3 Allocation of Seats**

Seats in the programs of study shall be allotted on the basis of preferences opted by the candidate, strictly in order of merit drawn based on marks scored in 10+2 in the 3 subjects as given in para 8.2 (b).

## 9. ADMISSION PROCEDURE – 10+2 MARKS BASED B T.ECH ADMISSION UNDER NRI CATEGORY

- 9.1** The merit shall be drawn, amongst the applications received under NRI /NRI sponsored category, based on the marks obtained in three subjects in 10+2 as given in Section 4.1 (b) under General Eligibility Criteria.
- 9.2** Candidates will be allotted seats strictly in order of merit. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission, subject to production of certificates of eligibility/ qualification and depositing of applicable Academic fee. The selected candidates will be informed about the allotted seats along with other relevant information through e-mail by the respective Universities. The candidate must therefore give their correct primary Email ID for communication.
- 9.3** Candidates who take admission under this category cannot opt for change to General/ Non-NRI category in subsequent years of the entire program duration.
- 9.4** Those who have already passed 10+2 examination should fill 10+2 marks in the application form and attach a photocopy of the marks sheet.
- 9.5** Candidates appearing in 10+2 examination of year 2025 should submit their results by the last date of application. Candidates who fail to submit their 10+2 marks sheet by the due date will not be considered for admission.
- 9.6** All candidates should compulsorily attach Sponsorship Letter from NRI or NRI certificate, as the case may be, along with the application form.
- 9.7** In case of offline application form, the completed application form must be submitted or sent to the University on the address given in para 5.3(d) above. On the top of the envelope, please mention 'Application under NRI/ NRI Sponsored Category'

## 10. ADMISSION PROCEDURE-LATERAL ENTRY ADMISSION TO 2<sup>ND</sup> YEAR B.TECH PROGRAM

Based on the applications received and meeting the eligibility criteria, merit shall be prepared based on CGPA/ Marks obtained in Diploma/B.Tech I year/B.Sc/D.Voc. Admission shall be offered based on the merit.

## 11. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - DIPLOMA PROGRAM

A merit will be drawn, on the basis of marks of qualifying examination results. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Academic fee.

## 12. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - MSc PROGRAM

A merit will be drawn, on the basis of marks of qualifying examination results. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Academic fee.

## 13. ADMISSION PROCEDURE - M.TECH PROGRAM

Candidates meeting the eligibility criteria will be required to appear in the PGET conducted by JUET, Guna. A merit will be drawn, on the basis of marks obtained in PGET. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Academic fee. GATE qualified candidates are exempted from appearing in PGET.

## 14. ADMISSION PROCEDURE PhD PROGRAM

Admission to PhD Program will be done through PhD Entrance Test followed by interview conducted by JUET Guna. NET/SLET/GATE qualified candidates are exempted from appearing in PhD Entrance Test. However, they will be required to appear for the interview conducted by the respective department. Admission will be offered purely on the basis of PhD Entrance Test Result and/or Interview. The admission will be provisional and subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of academic fee.

## 15. ADMISSION PROCEDURE BBA PROGRAM

A merit will be drawn, on the basis of marks of qualifying examination results. Selected candidates will be offered provisional admission subject to production of eligibility certificates and deposition of Academic fee.

## 16. ACADEMIC FEE STRUCTURE

### One Time Charge:

- (i) **Caution Money** - Caution Money of Rs. 20000/- is to be deposited at the time of admission for B.Tech programs and Rs. 5000/- for all other programs. The caution money is a one-time charge which is refundable after completion of the program.
- (ii) **Counselling Charges** – One-time non-refundable counselling charge to be deposited by all candidates at the time of admission as follows:

- (iii) **Hostel Charges** - Hostel Charges (if allotted) per semester including food and laundry shall be Rs. 80000/- for Non-NRI Category and USD 1100 for NRI Category. The charges are applicable for the AY 2025-26. The charges are subject to revision due to hike in the cost of commodities and other associate facilities as and when deemed fit by the Management.

## 17. REFUND POLICY

Last date of admission is as allowed /communicated by regulatory bodies. If a student leaves the program, fee shall be refunded as per UGC/AICTE Notifications.

### **Refund of Hostel Charges:**

- a) Till the date of Registration in program, a candidate is entitled for full refund of advance of Hostel charges, provided the student does not occupy the Hostel in advance.
- b) From the date of Registration in the program, the amount shall be refunded on pro-rata monthly basis, even if student has not occupied the Hostel or not taken the key to the room.
- c) For calculation of pro-rata deduction/refund, the duration of the semester as per the academic calendar shall be considered and deduction shall be made on per month basis, even if hostel is occupied for part of a month i.e. even for a single day only.
- d) Refund after reporting at the allotted University is subject to submission of No Dues.

- 2.7 Once, application is submitted successfully, an application ID shall be allotted to the Candidate. The candidate shall also get an email of Confirmation from Getadmissions.com.
- 2.8 Candidates to ensure that the result of class 12th exam is uploaded before last date of application.
- 2.9 Candidate must check their application form carefully before final submission, as no change will be permitted after submitting the form.
- 2.10 Candidates to upload the following documents:
  - a) Class 12th Marksheet
  - b) Identity proof of Candidate
  - c) Proof of Citizenship
- 2.11 Admission will be based strictly in order of merit.
- 2.12 At the time of admission/registration, all original documents, as mentioned in admission offer letter, will be verified. All admissions will be subject to verification of facts from the original Certificates/documents of the candidates. If an applicant is found ineligible at a later stage after admission to the University, the admission will stand automatically cancelled. 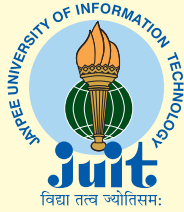

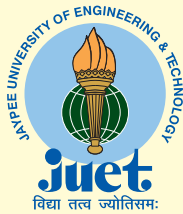
